



CNIGA Policy Statement

RE: Expansion of Gaming in California

The people of California have twice overwhelmingly voted to limit gaming to Indian tribes when they passed Propositions 5 and 1A. As a result of Proposition 1A, the state's constitution was amended by the voters of California to allow casino gambling on Indian lands only. CNIGA will uphold the right of California's tribes to conduct gaming on their own tribal lands and will oppose any attempt to expand gaming beyond Indian lands held in trust by the U.S. government.

Adopted December 3, 2003

Re-affirmed by a unanimous vote October 20, 2016

Protecting the sovereign right of California tribes to operate gaming on their lands.
